prayer for the early end of hostilities and expresses deepest appreciation in the name of the Jewish men in uniform for religious and morale services provided them by American Jewry through JWB. The Commission on Jewish Chaplaincy is made up of the representatives of the three major rabbinic bodies, Central Conference of American Rabbis (Reform), the Rabbinical Assembly (Conservative) and the Rabbinical Council of America (Orthodox).

With the approach of Passover 5729, we, the Jewish chaplains serving in South Vietnam, take this opportunity to greet the members of the American Jewish Community with best wishes and prayers for a most joyous and meaningful holiday.

Passover, the festival which stresses the importance and value of freedom, has traditionally been a time for reunion. Jewish families all over the world will gather to retell and re-enact the Passover story and message. Here in Vietnam, many thousands of miles from our homes and our families, Jewish servicemen will gather in many areas of the country to conduct Sedorim and form families of men brought together by a common heritage. They will relate the story of a struggle by our ancestors in Egypt to achieve freedom and human dignity. Vietnam is certainly an appropriate place to celebrate this festival since the Free-World forces are currently engaged in a struggle to bring freedom and human dignity to the people of Vietnam.

We express our sincerest gratitude to the Jewish community of the United States through the Commission on Jewish Chaplaincy and Women's organizations' Services of the National Jewish Welfare Board and its cooperating organizations, such as the Jewish federations and the United Jewish Appeal of Greater New York. Through your generosity, Kosher for Passover foods, Haggadot and literature will be available to men attending the central Sedorim as well as to those men who find themselves far from major installations and involved in tasks of utmost importance in the field.

We look to the future with great hope and conviction. We assure you we shall strive to maintain the high morale and purpose that we have had in the past. With continued support from the American Jewish community we shall be enabled to accomplish our mission of meeting the spiritual needs of our Jewish men and women.

We pray, that with the Almighty's help, a new era of universal peace will come to this troubled world. May the observance of the festival strike a responsive chord in our hearts and may all of us in Vietnam be enabled to celebrate next year's Passover safely at home with our loved ones.
