featured entertainer, received training in Italy.

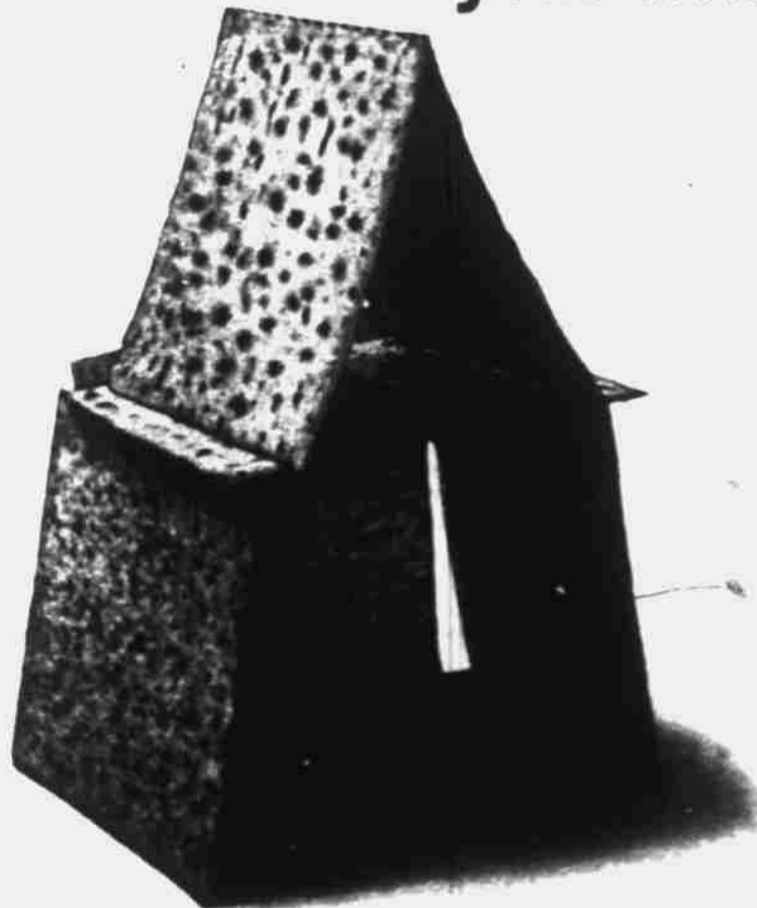
The Israel Emergency Fund helps to provide human Welfare costs, social service, health, education and welfare. It helps to assume the humanitarian responsibility for the one-and-a-
