*Passover Message*

The Board of Directors, the officers and the staff of the Joint Distribution Committee join me in wishing our fellow Jews throughout the world a happy and joyous Passover.

As Jewish families all over America seat themselves at the Seder table once more this year, even in the midst of this warmest and most intimate of family occasions the thoughts of many will reach to others far away.

It is in keeping with the Passover tradition to be concerned with those who cannot observe Passover according to the ancient ritual, who cannot honor it in a manner they would wish. For all too many Jews, to be "a slave in Egypt" is not a matter of past history, but a fact of today's existence.

Tens of thousands will be able to celebrate Passover this year because of the assistance provided by the Joint Distribution Committee, with United Jewish Appeal funds. Yet there are others whom the help of the JDC cannot reach, those in lands of oppression and anti-Semitism, some in ghettos or even behind prison walls.

It is most of all to them that our thoughts turn -- our thoughts and our hopes: our hope for that day when they too can join us in the warm and loving circle around the Seder table.

PHILADELPHIA -- The president of the American Jewish Congress has sharply criticized a proposal that the Nixon Administration adopt a new "evenhanded" policy in the Middle East. Rabbi Arthur J. Lelyveld, addressing the 50th anniversary meeting of the Congress here, did not mention William W. Scranton by name in referring to statements by the former Pennsylvania Governor, but the American Jewish Congress leader contrasted the "bitter irredentist hatred of the Arabs that seeks only to destroy" with what he called "Israel's determination to build for the good of all and the hurt of none."

NEW YORK (WNS) -- The 30th annual National Conference of the United Jewish Appeal has mandated the organization to conduct a "no limit" campaign in 1969 to meet "crucial human needs" in Israel and 30 other nations throughout the world. The 3,000 conference delegates re-elected Edward Ginsberg of Cleveland as general chairman and Max M. Fisher of Detroit as president. Mrs. Bernard Schaenen of Dallas elected national chairman of the Women's Division and Gordon Zacks of Columbus, O., was designated chairman of the National Young Leadership Cabinet.
