Nixon Shows a Hand

Mr. Nixon has ruled that the United States will go ahead with the proposed anti-ballistic missile system. His modifications and ratiionalizations, to the tune of seven to eight billion dollars, fly in the face of expert and some Senatorial rejection of the need for such a system.

It is clear that the Presidential decision appears to soothe the doves and satisfy the Hawks. It is also obvious that this is a big boondoggle for the Militaru - Industrial Complex, against which General Eisenhower warned the American people. There is another inherent danger in this decision. It augurs the same kind of concern for the off interests in the United States. If so, we can anticipate that Mr. Nixon will try to work out a formula which will soothe the friends of Israel and satisfy the Hawks, Unfortunately, here there is only one solution to peace in the Middle East. A face to face confrontation, Anything less will be a deal, maybe not quite Munich-style, but close enough to carry away with it the same stench.

REDS FOR TERROR

Israel's Ambassador to the United Nations, Yosef Tekoah, charges in a letter to the Security Council that the Soviet Government has approved the Arab terrorism directed against Israeli citizens. He cited an article





