Buddy said, "Our guests will include Rabbi Hillel Silverman of Temple Sinai and his family, Dick Martin and his girl friend, Susan Keith, maybe Dan Rowan and his wife if they can make it, the Mortons (Lucille Ball and Gary) and comedian Sid Gould, who works with Mickey Rooney."

Budy is hoping that his good friend, William B. Williams, who is the voice-over for many commercials, will be able to fly in from New York to join them as he has

done for other sedarim during previous years.

When asked for the names of his three children, who naturally will be on hand for the seder, Buddy apologized, "Sherry doesn't like to give out their names".
