JORDAN OPTION FOR US PLANES

WASHINGTON (WNS) --The United States has decided to keep open a Jordanian option to purchase additional Skyhawk jet fighters besides the aircraft already destined for Amman. The Defense Department also

disclosed that military deliveries have been made to Jordan in recent weeks and Jordanian military personnel, including pilots, were receiving training in the U.
