JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

NEW YORK -- Sixteen top experts in the field of communications will address a two-day conference on "Mass Communications and Jewish Life in America," to be held at the Jewish Agency Building, 515 Park Avenue, on Saturday evening, April 26th, and all day Sunday, April 27th.

NEW YORK, - The New York Chapter of the American Jewish Committee has joined the ranks of civic and social organizations opposed to the welfare cuts which are due to go into effect July 1.

BONN (WNS) -- The West German Government has been embarrased by the nomination by the eno-Nazi National Democratic Party of seven West German military officers and some non-commissioned officers, as party candidates for Parliament seats in September's national elections. About 50 officers and non-commissioned officers work actively for the NPD, often recruiting soldiers for the party.

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Gen. Jacob Hefetz, budget chief of Israel's Defense Ministry, has disclosed that Israel was spending \$2 million a day, seven days a week, for defense needs. He said Israeli gunners fired \$1.7 million worth of shells in four days of artillery duels with Egyptian forces across the Suez Canal three weeks ago.

LONDON (WNS) -- A British oil expert has described the Israeli oil pipeline now under construction between Ellat and the Mediterranean and a projected Egyptian pipeline paralleling the Suez Canal as unlikely economic competition of supertankers which, he said, could carry oil more cheaply from the Persian Gulf to Europe via the Cape of Good Hope. The Israeli effort, to cost \$100 million, will have a 20 million ton capacity when it opens next year and an ultimate volume of 50 million tons. A number of countries are bidding on the Egyptian pipeline which is to cost \$120 million with a 50 million ton initial capacity.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Six Americans and one Canadian are competing in the Tenth International Bible Contest For Jewish Youth to be held in Jerusalem April 23rd and 21 anniversary of the establishment of the State of Israel.

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- The Ministry of Education and Culture will conduct an art competition in Israeli high schools centered on the Eighth World Maccabiah Games to be held in Tel Aviv July 28 - Aug. 7. A commemorative stamp featuring the Maccabiah torch will be issued by the Postal Service with First Day Service scheduled for July 28.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Israeli geologists have reported discovering "vast water resources" under the Sinal Desert at depths of several hundred yards but noted it would be "an enormous task" to bring the water to the surface.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Pioneer Women, the women's Labor Zionist Organization of America, has called on Jewish families to hold Yom Haatzmaut (Israel Independence Day) celebrations at home as "an effective and tangible way to strengthen the bonds between our children and the people of Israel.
