### Voters. Don't be Suckers

Are the voters of Las Vegas mice or men? Its an off-year primary election, and a dull one at that, but the citizens of the City of Las Vegas have an opportunity to prove once and for all whether they are the bosses of their own destinies or whether they want to surrender these rights to the office holders they elect.

As one member of our community, the writer of this column, maintains, and stoutly so, that when a candidate for election comes hat in hand, pleading for our vote, that candidate, if elected, is our servant and not our master. When a man places his name on the ballot, presumably as a public spirited citizen willing to give of his time and efforts for the benefit of his community, it would appear that his sole and primary purpose as an office holder would be to carry out the demands and desires of those who made his position possible. But this is not always the case.

Six months ago a majority of our citizens voted to give the firemen a raise. Up until this very moment there has been no increase in wages. Why?

An elected mayor, four elected city commissioners and an elected city attorney, have decided among themselves that the public was wrong, stupid, idiotic, unlawful, in voting the firemen the salary boost. They, the elected "unofficials", have utilized public time and effort and public funds to thwart and override the public mandate. They threatened higher taxes, even printed and mailed out forms with a 75 per cent increase, only to recall this maneuver when it was determined to be illegal. Then they started proceedings claiming the voters had no right to give the firemen the raise, that it was outside the jurisdiction of
