ISRAEL CAN HANDLE SUEZ

JERUSALEM (WNS) - The stepped up tempo of fighting along the Suez Canal and the Jordan River and its political effect in major capitals in causing concern among Israeli leaders.

Egyptian artillery attacks and commands probes across the Suez Canal have become a daily occurrence and have resulted in a slight increase in the number of casualties reported in Israel, but military leaders said the situation was still controllable and that Israel forces would have no diffi-

culty in turning back any major cross-racial landing attempted by Egypt.

Cairo radio was now claiming that its commando forces had been crossing the waterway and engaging Israeli forces in raids and ambushes since the end of the Six-Day War. Jerusalem has been reporting that parts only since the end of February.

Israeli leaders were especially concerned over a report to the United Nations Security Council by Secret-
