A badly needed new deal in City Hall tops Winston E. Bell's agenda in his campaign for a place on the Las Vegas city commission, and he promises it will become his first order of business when he assumes office.

Bell, a former post commander of the Veterans of Foreign Wars, declares he will become "a spokesman for the people" following the forthcoming election.

Political Hopefuls

"I intend to obtain the pay raises which were voted for the firemen of our city," he said. "In addition, I will carry the fight for increased salaries for all deserving city employees based on their experience and qualifications."

Bell, who operates his own barber shop here, noted that the money which is spent in continually training new personnel would be saved "with dividends" if city government was operated more realistically.

"It is plain common sense that we'd be saving the taxpayer money if we paid our city employees a decent salary which would keep them on the job instead of being confronted with a constant turnover in personnel on all levels," he observed. "My primary interest in seeking office is to serve the com-

munity on all levels and my fellow veterans who are entitled to fullest representation on the communities they served."

Bell, 35, is married and has two children. He has lived in Las Vegas for 20 years and resides at 612 Halifax Circle.

He has been a member of the Barber's Union since 1955.
