JUSTICE MOWBRAY

Justice John Mowbray of the Nevada Supreme Court will participate in a National Defender Conference sponsored by the Department of Justice and the American Bar Association to be held at the Department of State in Washington, D. C. from May 14 to 16, 1969.

Justice Mowbray, who was instrumental in establishing Clark County's Defender system, the first for Nevada, will participate in a plenary session of the conference to discuss education and financing of defender services. Mowbray will serve as a member of a panel with three other Jurists head-

ed by Mr. Justice Tom Clark, former associate Justice of the United States Supreme Court and who is now director of the Federal Judicial Center. The other two panelists serving with Mowbray are Chief Justice W. N. Ethridge, Jr., of Supreme Court of Mississippi and United States District Judge John C. Oliver of Missouri.

James D. Santini, Clark County's present public defender, will also serve as a discussion group panelist with other outstanding defenders chosen from throughout the United States.
