It is a war being waged by neighbors who refuse to make peace, and who constantly violate the ceasefire agreement by infiltration, sabotage, shellings and other war-like acts. Whether it is a brief mor-

tar attack on an isolated border kibbutz, a grenade thrown into the entrance of a place of worship, a bomb planted in a crowded theater, bus terminal or public street, or even an all-out artillery barrage along one of Israel's lines of defense -the cost of this continuous fighting remains high in lives new and more sophisticated and money.

More than a year and a half

after the Six Day War, Is-

rael remains a nation at war.

The graves of the hundreds of men, women and children killed since the Six Day War -- and the hospitals busy rehabilitating the wounded -- attest to the cost in human suffering.

The tiny bunks crammed into the gas-proof bombshelters where kibbutz children sleep every night; the lines of tension on faces too young
