

JWV EXPOSES NEO-NAZI ANTI-SEMITE

Milton Becker of White-stone, N. Y. National Action Chairman, has written Joseph Ross, Department of California JWV Commander, calling for action against Willis Carto.

Carto was exposed in the Washington Post-Pearson column of April 17th which broke the story of the well financed neo-Nazi movement in our country dedicated to the United States government.

Becker said: "This group, known as the Francis Parker Yockey movement, founded by Willis Carto, a long time wholesaler of anti-Semitic material, is a no 'way-out

lunatic fringe gang'. It is a secret group of upper-middle class professional and business men acknowledging Hitler and 'Hitler's way' as their goal, with important influence on the national and Congressional scene.

Carto and these neo-Nazis function through various front groups quite successfully. For example, they have recently taken over the former 'Youth for Wallace', then named the National Youth Alliance, and now controlled by Carto as a committee of his 'Action Associates Inc'.

Carto controls the Ameri-

can Mercury magazine and is the founder of the Liberty Lobby, another front group that furnishes research and writes speeches for a dozen members of Congress. Many of these Congressmen have accepted awards, spoken at Lobby rallies and even solicited subscriptions for its newsletter.

We have no way of determining if they have any knowledge of Carto, his group or the origins of the Liberty Lobby. We do know many of them are in high places in our government and Defense structure."

Becker requested letters be sent to all the Congressmen and Senators.

ISRAEL DENIES

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Israel has denied a report in the Washington Post that it had rejected a deal whereby Egypt would release 200 imprisoned Jews in exchange for an Egyptian fighter pilot who was shot down over the Sinai last winter. Israeli officials said the pilot, reportedly the son of a high Egyptian intelligence official, was being treated under terms of the Geneva Convention covering military personnel and the Red Cross was handling his release.

Israeli officials said there was no connection between release of the pilot and release of Jews still in Egypt. The newspaper story by sy-

ndicated columnists Rowland Evans and Robert Novak asserted that Israel rejected the exchange deal because Jerusalem did not want the release of the Jews to weaken its charges that Arab countries were mistreating Jews and forbidding them to leave.

The columnists' report from Cairo said Egypt had planned to release the 200 Jews but held back when the pilot was downed and then proposed an exchange. The report asserted that Israel hoped to extract information from the pilot. But observers in Jerusalem indicated that Israel probably wanted to keep the pilot to insure humane treatment of any of its soldiers captured by Egypt.

ARAB BOYCOTT

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- Officials of the Department of State and Commerce have urged a Senate subcommittee not to propose new legislation against the Arab boycott of American firms trading with Israel. These Nixon Administration officials said the boycott had not weakened Israel and the present law calling on American businessmen to refuse to cooperate with the boycott was enough.

Enacting mandatory restriction against the boycott would only chose profitable Arab markets to American business and industry, the Government officials argued.
