UNITED NATIONS (WNS) -- Big Four negotiators have reportedly reached agreement on six general principles for a Middle East settlement but are still divided on the two basic points separating the Arabs and Israel.

Agreement was reached on the following points:

\*The Nov. 22, 1967 UN Security Council resolution must be the basis for a settlement and should be fully carried out.

\*The four powers reiterated their support of the UN

special envoy Gunner V. Jarring's peace mission.

\* No solution will be imposed on the two sides but the powers will make suggestions through Dr. Jarring as to the nature of the settlement.

\* The settlement should be a "package deal" involving all elements and to be carried out when the entire agreement is accepted by both sides.

\* The territory of all the nations must be respected and any boundary adjustments should not reflect the (Continued on Page 2)

### ARABS BOMB U. S. PIPELINE

JERUSALEM (WNS) --- Israeli authorities have reportedly told the American owners of an oil pipeline which runs through the Golan Heights that damages to the facility will not be repaired until guarantees are provided against any possible pollution from leakage and that stronger security arrangements be made for the pipeline.

Arab terrorists blew up a part of the line on the Golan Heights and oil seepage has caused some pollution to Lake Tiberias and to the Jordan River in north Israel, where settlements pump water from the river. Oil slicks could be seen on

the lake and the river, but water pumping was reportedly normal after being halted for a short while to let the oil dissipate.

The Arab commandoes that blew up a part of the line were attacked by a number of Arab nations for their action which was described as aiding the Zionists' cause. The guerrillas were charged with having economically injured the Arab cause which receives a large measure of support from oil-producing Arab states. The Arab nations had agreed that it was in the best interest of the Arab cause to allow this oil to flow freely (Continued on Page 6)

### IMPORTANT LETTER

Dear Mr. Tell:

A few weeks ago I read in your paper about a young woman who converted to Judaism. If she has fulfilled the Halachic requirements (Tvilah and acceptance of the Torah after study and practice as well as an examination by a recognized Rabbinic Court) she should feel completely unified with the Jewish people and their faith. Immersion in water in Judaism, as in many other religions, signifies total purity and renewal. Once someone has immersed in a valid Mikvah and freely accepted the obligation of a practicing Jew, that person is considered a Jew in every

way. Jewish law recognizes a sensitivity of the convert and forbids anyone to put that person to shame even to the extent of mentioning a defeat suffered by non-Jews at the hands of Jews.

If a person has shown true sincerity in accepting the difficulties of the Jewish religion he or she is regarded as a true descendent of Abraham our Father. The one who castigates her or insults her needlessly should reflect on the Talmudic dictum that he who shames his fellow man in public loses his portion in the world to come.

### LONDON ALERTED TO PROTECT BEN GURION

LONDON (WNS) -- British Security officials have put into effect strict security measures for the June visit of former Premier David Ben-Gurion following the

disclosure in Denmark of an alleged Arab terrorist plot to assassinate the Israeli leader while he visited Brazil.

The exact date of Mr. Ben-Gurion's arrival, his timetable and his hotel are not being disclosed. Only the fact that he will address a Joint Palestine Appeal group and attend two receptions in his honor has been released.

Tightened security arrangements are also expected to be in force when Israeli Prime Minister Golda Meir visits London sometime in June. The exact date is currently the subject of discussions between Israel and Great Britain. It is not known whether this trip will proceed or follow a visit to Washington which Mrs. Meir is reportedly also planning

to make.

The London Daily Telegraph reported that investigations in Denmark and Sweden into the plot against Mr. Ben-Gurion have uncovered a network of secret agents maintained by the Palestine Liberation Army, an arm of the Palestine Liberation Organization, operating in Sweden. This group reportedly used only peaceful persuasion in their anti-Israeli activities, the newspaper reported.

In Denmark the three assassination suspects -- two Arab and a Swedish national -- were remanded to police custody for three weeks while authorities investigate the plot. The proceedings before the Danish high court in Copenhagen were secret but evidence disclosed to the newspaper indicated that

Rolf Anderson of Sweden was recruited by the PLA while stationed in the Gaza Strip with the United Nations peacekeeping force. The prosecution said he gave police the names of all members of the PLA group known to him.

Prosecution information established that an Egyptian colonel in the PLO visited Stockholm in May to arrange for the two accused Arabs -- a 25-year-old Iraqi and a 24-year-old Jordanian -- to be hidden in Copenhagen from Israeli security agents who might be on their trail. From Denmark the two were to take a jet plane to Rio de Janeiro and arrive just before Mr. Ben-Gurion did. They were to assassinate him at the airport using either hand grenades or hand guns, both of which were found among the possessions of the two Arabs.
