Tony Bennett, one of the few singers who have found the magic key to adult and teenage audiences, and to musicians, songwriters and other singers, returns to the Circus Maximus theatre - restaurant at Caesars Palace.

Opening with Bennett will be Louie Bellson and his orchestra, and comedian Bob Melvin. Woody Herman and his orchestra will open Thursday, June 26, replacing Louie Bellson on the bill.

Unique among America's popular singers, Bennett has a fantastic choice of superior songs, songs that stick in the memory instead of flaring up and then dying quickly. His repertoire includes songs he first introduced and personally made popular, all the way from his first big record success "Because of You" in 1951 to "San Francisco" and his most recent hit "Yesterday I Heard The Rain."

Next up in the Circus Maximus following the Bennett show are Petula Clark and George Kirby, July 17-August 6.

BOTTOMS UP BACK

Breck Wall and Joe Peterson's "Bottoms Up", the most successful afternoon comedy revue in Las Vegas

entertainment history, returns to Caesars Palace with its 1969 edition Friday, after taking an 18-day "rest." "Bottoms Up" will appear twice daily (2:30 and 4:30 p.m., except Thursdays) in the hotel's new Roman Theatre.

Mart Crowley's prize-winning "The Boys in the Band" opens in the Roman Theatre and will continue twice nightly (8:40 p.m. and midnight) performances for a limited engagement.

In addition to Wall, co-producer and one of the "bottoms up" stars since the show's inception eleven years ago, the laugh-loaded revue features robust comedienne Thelma Pelish, plus Wall's and her partners in mischief and mayhem, David Harris, Rob Barron, Suzanne Buhner, Temple Greenwood, Bettina Brenna, Jan Sutton.

The 1969 edition has a new opening and features old and new blackouts, psychedelic dances, TV commercials, musical and comedy spoofs, and general all-around fun.

This is the third consecutive year that "Bottoms Up" has played indefinite engagements at Caesars Palace.
