HU THANT REPORTS TO U.N. ON MIDEAST

OPEN WARFARE RESUMED

BULLETIN!!

UNITED NATIONS NY (WNS) - U Thant, Secretary General of the United Nations warned in a special report to the UN Security Council that he may have to withdraw the 96 UN Cease Fire Observers from the Suez Canal area because "open warfare has been resumed" there Mr. Thant said UN observers "cannot be

expected to serve as what amounts to defenseless targets in a shooting gallery." As of July 5 Mr. Thant reported, firing across the Suez had gone on for 86 consecutive days. During June he reported there were 21 incidents of firing by the Egyptian and five by Israeli forces on UN personnel or (Continued on Page 2)
