King cannot." The implication was tied to the situation along the Suez Canal where Israeli air power had destroyed Egyptian positions along the east bank. Since those raids, military action along the waterway has de-escalated to sporadic artillery and mortar exchanges. While both sides are still sustaining casualties, Israeli military officers welcomed the relative quiet but noted Egypt was rebuilding its forces for another round in what has been called the "Battle for the battle". They noted that as long as Israel can disrupt the enemy, Cairo cannot launch massive attacks across the canal in its long proclaimed battle to regain the Sinai.

a guerrilla group ambushed an Israeli Army patrol in Gaza Saturday and injured four soldiers. Earlier in the week an Israeli Army major shot it out with a gang of terrorist in a Western-style gun battle after a hand grenade was hurled at a local cafe.

the Major and two Israeli soldiers were also injured. Four guerrillas were killed south of the Dead Sea when an Israeli patrol intercepted the group. A number of weapons were recovered.

(In London, a western news man reported that Arab children between nine and 18 years of age are being trained to fire machine guns at the Bakka refugee camp in Jordan. The correspondent said that one of the Arab guerrilla fighters who patrol the camp told him the youngsters are recruited into so-called "lion's cub" centers where they are taught how to fire machine guns, rifles and pistols and are instructed in field craft.)

Life sentences were pronounced last Thursday on six El Fatah guerrillas convicted of terrorist acts. The gang was captured near Nahal Gol Dotan in the Jordan Valley May 4. One of their number was killed. All of the accused were uncooperative at their trial and expressed regret that they could not complete the sabotage mission. The prosecutor did not request capital punishment.

**JWV: ANTI-SEMITISM STEMS FROM COMMUNISTS**

The Jewish War Veterans of the United States charged that elements among the Leftist and New Left movements in the United States and other non-Communist countries made subtle appeals to anti-Jewish passions among "enemies of the Establishment" by injecting anti-Zionist and anti-Israel positions in their writing and public statements.

William Lieberman, El Paso, Texas, 6th Regional Commander of the Jewish War Veterans of the U.S.A., which headquarters in Los Angeles, California, made known that National Commander Charles Feureisen has asked JWV's staff to "evaluate the injection of anti-Semitism as to whether any of it stems from Communist efforts."

JWV has noted: "Communist theoreticians are maliciously linking Israel with imperialism and colonialism and associating Jews in the United States and elsewhere with reactionary elements. The Jew is depicted as the enemy of those striving for change. Jewish groups are used as the symbol for the hated 'power structure'."

THE JWV Commander said: "Although Jews remain in the forefront of democratic and humanitarian causes, as scapegoats, they are today maligned as reactionaries, nationalists, and exploiters." Moscow and Warsaw after Israel defeated Communist-supported Arab aggression in June, 1967, is now echoed in the 'New Left' especially among same campus groups."

The JWV will undertake to focus attention on "this dangerous newly devised form of anti-Semitism," the Commander added. He said that "the Communists are

exploiting revolutionary changes in the United States and many parts of the world, subtly injecting the poison of anti-Semitism, turning race against race, religion against religion, group against group and generation against generation."

"Jews are depicted as agents of the status quo against which the angry, and underprivileged are being rallied by Leftist agitators," he said. "This subtle new Communist line would obscure the great service of American Jewry to the cause

of social justice and reform. It would denounce true social democracy exemplified in the Middle East by Israel."
