

**AMERICA FIRST AT MACCABIAH, ISRAEL SECOND**

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- American teams won a lopsided victory in the eight Maccabiah games, Israel's little Olympics, capturing

63-1/2 gold medals, 40-1/2 silver medals and 34-1/2 bronze medals.

Israel was second in the week-long competition with

48 gold, 52-1/2 silver and 51 bronze medals. Britain, with 10-1/2 gold medals, took third place.

The big upset in the games was Israel's 74-70 victory over the United States in the basketball finals before a crowd of 5,000 in the Ramat Gan stadium. It was the first American defeat in basketball since the Maccabiah games were started 20 years ago.

Deputy Premier Yigal Allon in Jerusalem voiced the hope that the next Maccabiah games will see Jewish athletes from Eastern European countries participating. He was addressing the 1500 participants in the eighth Maccabiah, who together

with their entourage, visited Jerusalem and held a rally on Mt. Scopus. Mr. Allon told them that lasting peace could be achieved only at the negotiation table. He said when that stage is reached, "we have a lot to offer the Arabs."

In the United States more than 1,500 members of Zionist youth organizations participated in the annual American Zionist youth version of the Maccabiah games. The event at Camp Tel Yehudah, the camp of Hachar (Young Judea) at Barryville, N.Y. was sponsored by the American Zionist Youth Foundation.
