TEL AVIV (WNS) -- A Dayan, was a controversial pledge by Premier Golda issue at the convention, The Meir that even if the opportunity for peace in the Mideast arose, Israel will not "forgo one inch of land if it means endangering our security border" failed to lessen the differences between Israeli leaders over the future of the occupied Arab lands.

These differences were evident at the Israel Labor Party convention which ended without approving key planform planks dealing with security, foreign policy and policy toward the occupied territories. Those Arab planks were referred to the party's central committee which was empowered to make a final decision. The left-wing Mapam party, which has entered into a political alignment with the Labor Party, followed an identical course at its own convention.

The plank on Israel's security frontiers, proposed by Defense Minister Moshe

disagreement was apparently not on the substance of the proposals but over the wisdom of officially committing Israel's major political party to them at this time. Gen. Dayan proposed that Israel permanently retain the Golan Heights, the Gaza Strip and a section of the Sinai Peninsula linking it with the Sharm el-Shiekh strongpoint and that their Jordan River be established as Israel's eastern security frontier. Gen. Dayan agreed that his proposals should constitute an "unwritten" platform plank wich Party speakers could refer to during the election camp-

But Foreign Minister Abba Eban and other leading Party members feared that such a plank might impair Israel's image as a peaceseeking nation and harm prospects for eventual peace negotiations.
