Mr. Hermon in Lebanon which contained a concentration of Arab guerilla bases. Israeli sources said the raid was carried out in response to an escalation of sabotage and terrorist activities from Lebanese territory in which Arab commandos encamped on Lebanese soil have carried out 21 attacks during the past month. The guerilla enclave near the Israeli border is not controlled by the government.

(Lebanon complained to the United Nations over the Israeli raid and asked for and received a special meeting of the Security Council).

Premier Meir warned Lebanon that it could not escape responsibility for the activities of Arab guerillas operating from Lebanese soil. She said, "if Lebanese authorities could not deal with them; we shall have to."

Israeli jets Wednesday went into action to silence Jordanian and Egyptian artillery which had been pounding Israeli positions for hours.

A military spokesman said one Israeli soldier was killed and two were wounded by Jordanian shells near the Abdallah bridge in the southern Jordan Valley just north of the Dead Sea. Three Israelis were killed and 17 wounded, four of them seriously, in an Egyptian barrage south of Port Tewfik near the southern access to the Suez Canal.

The targets in the canal zone were Egyptian shore batteries at Tel El Adabyeh,

Naval Station south of Port Suez where the Egyptians massed 155 guns. Direct hits were scored on Jordanian positions and fires were seen rising from Jordanian tanks.

A military spokesman said the Egyptians have also resumed their commando penetrations of the Israeli-occupied East Bank of the canal but have restricted operations to sabotage and mine-laying. Vehicles and a tractor were damaged by mines last week. Egyptian commandos also sabotaged a telephone cable south of Ismailia.

(Amman Radio on Wednesday reported King Hussein of Jordan formed a new cabinet including pro-guerilla politicians who have not served in previous Jordanian Governments. Their appointment was a clear sign that guerilla warfare would increase.)

A gang of 30 saboteurs in the Ramallah and Jerusalem regions were arrested Israeli security sources disclosed Thursday. The gang included members of El Fatah and the Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine. Their apprehension yielded three caches of machine-guns, hand grenades and high explosives.

Arab saboteurs for the second time in less than a month blasted an oil refinery in the Haifa port area on Friday, rupturing a pipeline, damaging an electric pylon and touching off a fire over a 500-year area. Firemen controlled the blaze in 45 minutes after closing a valve that shut off the flow of
