ISRAEL NORMAL DESPITE TENSION

According to Time, "The U.S. State Department believes the Israelis retain overwhelming superiority despite the Arabs' having more than twice as many planes. Thus, though Washington is committed to delivering 50 Phantoms to Israel this fall, it is likely to delay any decision on Jerusalem's recent request to buy 25 additional Phantoms and 80 Skyhawks."

(Israel has about 300 French and American-built combat planes against about 800 Soviet - supplied MIGs and Sukhois in the combined Arab air forces.) But the quality of Israeli pilots is vastly superior to Arab flyers and its planes "are kept in superb condition. Eighty to 90 percent of them are ready."
