CZECHS HIT ARABS

PRAGUE (WNS) -- Rude Pravo, the Czech Communist daily, has assailed the Arab states for trying to use the Al Aksa mosque fire as the basis for a Moslem holy war against Israel. The paper said the Arabs, rather than calling for an all-Arab conference to discuss the fire, tried to arrange a Moslem conference in an attempt to turn the Mideast conflict into a "holy war against the enemies of Islam." Rude Pravo warned that this cannot arouse support for the Arab cause.

Justice David Zenoff, Supreme Court of Nevada, will be the recipient of special honors to be conferred on him by both the State of Israel and the National Israel Bond Organization, at the annual dinner to be held on Sunday evening, October 12, at Caesar's Palace.

Justice Zenoff will be cited as, "one who has rendered extraordinary service in every field of humanitarian endeavor and who has helped to advance the development of the State of Israel."

Howard P. James, Dinner Chairman of the Las Vegas Israel Bond Committee, said that "while we are doing honor to an outstanding citizen such as Justice Zenoff, out of the proceedings will come a practical means of helping Israel to maintain its economic independence."

"In the short space of two decades Israel has achieved a unique record of growth. In its economic development, as well as its pioneering agricultural settlement, Israel has won world-wide recognition as an example of progress. Although it has made enormous strides as a young developing nation with the aid of Israel Bonds, it still faces many problems

in reconstruction and economic development," he added.

Justice Zenoff is a native of Wisconsin and he was admitted to the Bar in that state in 1940, followed by the Nevada Bar in 1948.

Before his appointment to the Supreme Court bench in 1965, Justice Zenoff served as District Court Judge of the Eighth Judicial District Court, to which he was named in 1958.

The jurist has a close identification with the model youth camp project, Spring Mountain Youth Camp, which aids boys between the ages of

Israel Must Live

With the United Nations convening and serious incidents taking place practically every day in and about the Middle East, we believe the setting is ripe for an inventory on the status of the State of Israel.

World opinion, which used to be the barometer and possibly a deterrent for actions by nations, has lost its effectiveness and no longer may be considered a potent force, mainly because of its abuse by majority members of Communist nations supporting the Arabs, voting in a block. No matter how overwhelming the facts are in favor of the righteousness of an action taken by Israel, always in retaliation, Russia, followed by her satellites and each of the Arab countries, take long, tedious hours delivering redundant tirades against Israel. The controlled press of these countries print screaming headlines of the false charges with no reference or any indication of the reasonable counter-statements of the representative from Israel.

Every now and then the Democratic nations, like Canada, the U. S. and Britain, probably to put an end to the incessant time-consuming, rehashing of charges, vote to censure Israel. At one time this was an all-important measure, and while Israel is very cognizant of a true feeling of world opinion, the part being over-played by propagandists in the U. N. has rendered their actions null

ISRAEL NIXES UNITED NATIONS

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- The Israeli Government has decided not to cooperate with a United Nations investigation of the status of Arabs in the occupied territories.

The decision, taken at the highest levels of the Government, was made after considering what Israel might gain from such a study. Israeli leaders decided that the nation could not receive a fair hearing due to the composition of the UN and the membership of the study committee.

The committee is composed of Yugoslavia and Somalia, which have no diplomatic relations with Jerusalem, and Ceylon, which maintains relations but has consistently voted with the Arab states or Arab-Israeli matters.

The General Assembly last December voted to set up a special committee to investigate the status of Arabs in the occupied areas. The Guatemalan delegation

was charged with selecting the committee and tried to pick nations which had abstained in the Assembly vote. Although there were many nations which did so, none agreed to join the committee and three states that had voted for the investigation were finally selected.

Israel's decision means the committee will not be allowed inside Israel and it will have to obtain information in Arab lands, Israeli
