

NON-JEW URGES RENEWED EFFORT FOR ISRAEL

A non-jewish leader in the Las Vegas Committee for State of Israel Bonds has called for "renewed effort by Nevadans to support the economic needs of the young, Democratic nation of Israel."

Howard P. James, who is serving as dinner chairman of the Oct. 12 State of Israel Tribute Dinner honoring Justice David Zenoff, issued a statement following the start of the Jewish New Year of 5730.

"The realization of the Biblical promise of the return of the Jewish people to Israel," Mr. James declared, "has been marked by a historic humanitarian achievement in which Israel has been the instrument in the rebirth of Jewish life after a generation that witnessed the mass persecution and destruction of millions of Jews during World War II."

"It is my fervent hope for a renewed effort by Nevadans to support the economic needs of the young, democratic nation of Israel."

It behooves us, as humanitarians, and also in honor of our own friend and leader, Judge Zenoff, to extend our helping hands at this time of the start of a new Jewish year."

Justice Zenoff will be honored both by the State of Israel and the National Israel Bonds Organization for his humanitarian efforts for Israel through the past decade.

"I hope that Nevadans will respond with a tremendous

campaign in behalf of Israel," Mr. James said, "for the Israel Bond Campaign represents a program that can help restore Israel as a source of spiritual renewal and hope for all mankind, as well as for the Jewish people."

"Our kinship, in this country, with the people of Israel has found expression in concrete action, in aiding the economic development of that country through the channel of Israel bonds."

"The growing impact of the Israel Bond program has made itself felt in large-scale development of the land, its agriculture and industry, which has furthered the absorption of some 1,400,000 refugees of persecution during the past two decades."

"These remarkable strides in nation-building testify to the vitality of the 21-year-old State of Israel and to its ability to overcome the obstacles of limited natural resources and the hostility of its neighbors."
