TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Leaders of the Israeli Labor Party and its rebellious Rafi faction have reached an accord under which Rafi members are expected to remain within the ILP.
The agreement calls for Gen. Moshe Dayan to retain the portfolio of Defense Minister in the new government to be formed after the October elections. In addition, Rafi will be given another ministerial post, not counting the Labor Ministry cur rently held by Rafi member Yosef Almogi.
