America's Sweetheart

The woman who only this year became Israel's forth Prime Minister made a tremendous impact on the millions who saw and heard her during her first state visit to the USA last week. She won her way into the hearts of not only the President of the United States, but also his Cabinet and State Department officials.

Because Mrs. Meir is a mother and grandmother, she superimposes her motherly feelings and family ties with national destiny. It was her generation who reclaimed the land in Israel. It was her children who fought the wars, and she has strong feelings that it should now be her grandchildren who should enjoy the peace.

"Peace is urgent not only for Israel but for the Arabs themselves," she said during an interview here at The Mayflower Hotel. "Remember,

the Arabs have really been the victims of their own leaders, whose policies have been irresponsible and negative. However, Israel will not settle for anything but REAL peace. We won't fool ourselves that what is not REAL peace is peace. We've done that before."

Mrs. Meir emphasized that no pressure, however forceful, will persuade Israel to change its objectives in its search for peace in the embattled Mideast. She is strongly convinced that peace can come with face to face negotiations between the Arabs and the Israelis, and that the Big Four powers cannot really be useful in working out a Peace Plan.

"Only parties who make war can make peace" she declared. "The leaders of the Arab countries cannot shirk their responsibility of negoti-
