

JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

LOS ANGELES: Max Dane, Chairman of the National Program Committee of the Anti-Defamation League, announced appointment of Mr. Bruce L. Hochman to the Vice-Chairmanship.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- The Jewish Agency has rejected a proposal that the Israeli Government's Ministry for Immigrant Absorption take over most of the Agency's immigration activities.

PHILADELPHIA, -- Jews currently comprise 12-1/2 per cent of all bank directors in Philadelphia and three per cent of all bank officers in the city. Ten years ago, Jews accounted for only two per cent of bank directors and one per cent of bank officers. The Philadelphia Chapter of the American Jewish Committee and the Philadelphia Jewish Employment and Vocational Service, gave this progress report of the Executive Advisory Program of the two agencies covering the decade 1959-69.

NEW YORK - Edgar B. Speer, President, United States Steel Corporation, has been named recipient of the 1969 American Jewish Committee Human Relations Award, it was announced by George S. Moore, chairman of FIRST National City Bank, who is serving as dinner chairman of testimonial Oct. 13.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- The name of Deputy Premier Yigal Allon has been placed after Premier Golda Meir and before Foreign Minister Abba Eban in a last minute shift of the election list of the Labor - Party-Mapam alignment.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Sixteen parties including four new groups have submitted lists to the Knesset elections committee for the national elections. The new groups include one headed by former Premier David Ben-Gurion.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- The Conservative Day School movement has opened four new schools to bring its total to 33 schools in 22 communities in the United States and Canada. Enrollment totals 5,000 students while there are 410 faculty members in the system.

LOS ANGELES (WNS) -- A Union of American Hebrew Congregations (Reform) sponsored introductory course on Judaism given in Los Angeles for 15 years has been attended by more than 6,000 persons, many of them having enrolled as first step toward conversion. Some 60 percent of the 600 students attending each year are non-Jewish.

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- A record 4,500 students from 36 nations have enrolled at Bar Ilan University for the 1969-70 academic year. The total includes more than 500 Americans and Canadians.

LOS ANGELES: Mr. Benjamin R. Epstein, National Director of the Anti-Defamation League of B'nai B'rith will be guest speaker at Annual Appeal Dinner of the ADL November 9, 1969, at 6:30 P.M. in the Crystal Ballroom of the Beverly Hills Hotel.

NEW YORK: "Gracious and tenacious," Israel Premier Golda Meir has had a "tremendous impact" on the U. S. Jewish community during her visit here, said Rabbi Herschel Schacter, chairman of the Conference of Presidents of Major American Jewish Organizations. Not since David Ben-Gurion's trip to the U. S. in 1951 as the first leader of a Jewish state in nearly 2,000 years have American Jews been so stirred by any visitor as by Mrs. Meir.

JERUSALEM - The American College in Jerusalem, opening its second year as an English language institution of higher learning in Jerusalem, held its inaugural academic convocation October 7, 1969, it was announced by College President Professor Norman Greenwald.

PARIS (WNS) -- Gaullist deputy Jean Mercier told a meeting of the French Committee for Solidarity with Israel that the Government's "general attitude toward Israel has changed favorably in recent months" and hinted at a partial lifting of the arms embargo imposed on Israel by former President Charles de Gaulle.

RIO DE JANEIRO (WNS) -- El Fatah, the Arab terrorist organization, is reportedly seeking recruits and support from among the 14,000 Arab refugees who have entered Brazil since the end of the Six-Day War.

BONN (WNS) -- West Germany has given Israel a \$35 million grant for new development projects, the same total as she allocated in 1968 after the Bonn-Jerusalem reparations agreement expired.

GUATEMALA CITY (WNS) -- The newspaper La Hora, owned by Guatemala's Vice President, Clemente Marroquin Aokas, has apparently ended publication of a regular series of anti-Semitic articles.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Hias treasurer Carl Glick has reported that the Agency will be required to spend \$2.8 million this year to meeting mounting refugees needs caused by events in Eastern Europe and the Arab world.

NEW YORK -- Thirty - one Young Americans and Canadians, ages 18-23, left for Israel September 30, for a half-year Sherut La'am service in Kibbutz Misgav - Am in the northern hills of Galilee. The number of Sherut La'am volunteers in 1969 totals 210. Sherut La'am was initiated four years ago and is sponsored by the American Zionist Youth Foundation.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- The Jewish Telegraphic Agency, worldwide Jewish news association is accepting applications from college journalism students for its intern-training program to provide practical experience for potential reporters and editors for the American Jewish press.
