

MRS. MEIR SAYS NIXON UNDERSTANDS ISRAEL'S PROBLEMS

JERUSALEM (WNS) --- Premier Golda Meir indicated satisfaction with her visit to the United States on her return to Israel and had warm words for President Nixon.

Mrs. Meir described the American President to newsmen as a man "who listens and understands our problems." She added that he "is prepared and willing to pursue the same policy he is pursuing now -- mainly

to see to it that Israel's ability to defend itself will not fall short."

Finance Minister confirmed that Mrs. Meir asked Pres. Nixon for \$1 billion loan to keep offset military expenditures for next five years.

(It was reported from New York that the Premier met with a group of Jewish intellectuals at a private gathering at the home of author Elie Wiesel during her visit to the city.

(At the informal gettogether Mrs. Meir noted that "the world still does not accept us," and explained that "the non-Jewish world has been in two groups -- those that killed us and those that pit us."

(The Israeli leader, who noted during her trip in the U. S. that the anti-Jewish programs had played a key role in her becoming a Zionist and going to Palestine

to develop a home for the Jewish people, said that "before the war the decent non-Jewish people were with us, now we're alive and we're certainly not pitied."

"If we have to have a choice between being dead and pitied, and being alive with a bad image, we'd rather be alive and have the bad image," she said.

(Before the Six-Day War Israel was "in danger and I don't think there was anybody who wasn't an anti-Semite who wasn't concerned," she said. "All of a sudden," she noted sardonically, "all of the Arabs became poor Arabs. All of a sudden, people are concerned about the morale. Are we turning into militarists, into a Spartan state?"

"We won the war, and now we want peace. I don't think there is any gimmick that can change the attitude people have toward us. I say we have to do everything possible to get the facts across, and at the same time be misunderstood until there's peace.

"We haven't sinned in any way. What do you expect us to do when we have Fatah and terror?"

(She noted that Israel has destroyed homes that sheltered Arab terrorists but "after two years of terror, there has not been one execution in Israel," and added bitterly, "so knocking down a house becomes an act of barbarism."

(The Premier spoke of her visit to London and meeting with Foreign Secretary Michael Stewart. She noted that England "isn't what it used

to be, sometimes they forget. We were talking about the Four world powers who are trying to devise a Middle East solution, and he told me all this nonsense --- 'it won't be an imposed solution' and all the rest.

"Granted," I said. "But you wouldn't want even your best friends to decide your fate."

(Discussing former

French President Charles de Gaulle, Mrs. Meir said he "can't forgive us because he was the war casualty. He prophesied two things -- that this time Nasser would throw us into the sea and that there would be a world war."
