In its quarter century on radio, this program has won dozens of formal awards -about 70 in all -- and hundreds of thousands of informal awards, the letters of appreciation from Americans of all faiths, and perhaps even more encouraging these days, of all ages. It has been NBC's pride to be part of this, the broadcasting company working with the theological seminary, the artists with the scholars, the technicians with the rabbis.

In the Oct. 26 play, "A RHODE ISLAND REFUGE" by the late genius of his art Morton Wishengrad, an actor reads the words of Roger Williams, the founder of Rhode Island:

"All men may walk as their consciences persuade them, and every one in the name of God,"
