## ARSON TRIAL ON

JERUSALEM (WSN)--The trial of Denis Michael William Rohan, accused of setting a fire in the El Aska mosque, resumed after a two-and-a-half week recess and the 28-year-old Australian told the court he set the blaze in a carefully planned attempt to burn "one of Satan's temples."

While acknowledging the "crime" of setting the fire, he said he was not concerned about being tried under Israeli law because "I am king and I am above courts."

Mr. Rohan belongs to a fundamentalist Protestant sect which believes that the Messiah will return only after the Temple of Solomon is re-built on its site.

JERUSALEM (WNS) --- Premier Golda Meir has begun consultations to form a new coalition Government as her Israel Labor Party alignment failed to win an absolute majority in national balloting which saw Israeli voters bend to the right in their political preference.

A projection of results made by computer with results from armed forces balloting not included indicates that the Labor Party-Mapam alignment won 58 seats in

the 120-seat Knesset, a five seat drop from the 63 held in the outgoing Parliament. At the same time, the right-wing Gahal (Herut-Liberal alignment) increased their membership from 22 to 27 seats. A more extreme right-wing party, Free Center, which broke away from Gahal, lost three seats and now holds one.

Mrs. Meir had pledged to continue her national unity

## KOLLEK REELECTED IN JERUSALEM

JERUSALEM (WNS) --- Teddy Kollek was re-elected Mayor of Jerusalem in balloting which saw a heavy turnout of Arab voters despite reprisal threats by terrorists and a demand for a general strike broadcast by the Jordanian radio in Amman.

Mr. Kollek's Alignment List and an affiliated Merchants and Artisans List gained nearly 50 percent of the vote and may have an

absolute City Council majority when results are officially announced.

Mr. Kollek's victory and his overwhelming support from Arab voters were viewed as endorsement of the Mayor's policy of tolerance toward the Arabs and his efforts to have East Jerusalemites take a more active part in governing a united city.

Mayor Kollek said after
