SPACE AGE HOUSE WITH NATURAL GAS

A dramatic Space Age house with natural gas as its only energy source highlighted the American Gas Association's annual convention in Denver, Colo.

Unique gas energy concepts, many already feasible and others on the threshold of technological development, will be featured in a two-level model home exhibiting advanced applications for living room, kitchen, bath and utility room areas.

The Space Age home, a joint project of A.G.A. and the Institute of Gas Technology, Chicago, will demonstrate innovations such as:

Total comfort control provided directly by natural gas, but with equipment located outdoors, to heat and cool

automatically, humidify, and remove air impurities.

Radiant heating and lighting featuring a burner element which can be provided in a variety of shapes and capacities.

Hydrogen produces only pure water vapor as a combustion product, hence can be burned indoors without venting. It requires no ignition system such as a pilot light or spark device, and will burn on a catalyzed surface without a flame and at any desired temperature.

Hydrogen applications demonstrated in the Space Age house include a clear range surface with catalytic burner, a portable food warming tray, and a new concept of gas lighting,
