its forces since the Six-Day War and can now put 500,000 armed men in the battle against Israel. He praised the Soviet Union as a "true friend" who had helped to arm the nation.

Israel, Mr. Nasser claimed, was "fighting with its back to the sea." Egypt's position was "to be or not to be. There is no alternative but to continue to fight against Israel."

The United States was bitterly attacked by President Nasser who asserted that American militarists are fighting against Egypt "from behind guns and aircraft that carry the Star of David." He said, "The arms of the Soviet Union are in our hand, and the arms of the U.S. A. are in Israel's hands."

ISRAEL WILL RETALIATE

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Israel has strongly warned Beirut that it will take all appropriate measures to defend Israeli citizens and territory from commando raids launched from Lebanon.

The warning followed announcement of an agreement between Lebanon and Commando groups allowing the guerrillas greater freedom of operation against Israel from Lebanon territory.

A private message to this effect was reportedly sent by Premier Golda Meir to Lebanese President Charles Helou through nations which maintains diplomatic relations with Israel and Lebanon. At the same time, Foreign Minister Abba Eban issued a public warning during a television appearance.

Mr. Eban declared that "Israel favors the independence of Lebanon and her right to her own unique national and cultural character. However Lebanon is under an obligation to respect the independence and security of Israel and prevent any attack made from her territory on Israeli citizens and territory."

The Foreign Minister then said that Israel would react "in any way that seems effective" if Arab commando groups carried out raids on border settlements.

Mr. Eban's remarks were made after a Cabinet meeting to discuss the political and military situation following the agreement reached by the Arab guerrilla groups and Lebanon meeting in Cairo.

Israeli leaders are waiting to see how the agreement is carried out and what type of control Lebanon exerts over the commando groups. Military sources have indicated that Israel is prepared to carry out air attacks and even land action if this become necessary to check terrorist raids.

The agreement between the Palestine Liberation Organization, the central commando organization, and the Beirut Government -- never officially announced to the world but hailed as a vital ingredient in the war against Israel by Arab leaders and newspapers -- reportedly provides for a ceiling on commandos -- 2,000 is the figure mentioned -- to operate freely from the area they now occupy around Mount Hermon. The guerrillas reportedly agreed to infiltrate very small units and individuals and not carry out large platoon or company size attacks against Israel. They are also allowed to use an all-weather road to ferry men and supplies from Syria to replace a mountain road closed by snow during the winter.

The Lebanese control was centered on the restriction over the number of commandos and they type of missions they can launch against

Israel. The Arab belief is that the Lebanese Army will not allow raids of a magnitude that would result in massive Israeli retaliation.

One Lebanese official was quoted by Western newsmen as saying they saw nothing in the agreement that would unduly upset Israel. This implication was that the commandos would step up their shelling, minings and ambushes but at a level that Israel would still be willing to accept without reacting with massive counter raids.

Western Newsmen reported from Lebanon that Palestinians feel that the guerrilla movement gained nothing it did not have before the agreement and that there was resentment against the PLO, in refugee camps.

Observers in Israel noted that the most extreme terrorist organization, the left-ist Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine was not a member of the PLO and has said it was not bound by the agreement.
