ARABS RECORD MOST SUCCESSFUL WEEK

Arab forces recorded their most successful week in military activities against Ismilitary Israelispokesmen said in reporting on Egyptian naval attacks on Northern Sinai bases and five commando raids across the Suez Canal which resulted in three Israeli deaths.

The Egyptian naval activity -- the first since the Six Day War -- saw two destroyers and several smaller craft shell Israeli military posts in the Romani area near the Mediterranean coast 25 miles east of the canal. Israeli jets drove off the Egyptian warships and reporters who visited the scene said that the Arab shelling had resulted in no damage.

FRANCE MAINTAINS EMBARGO

PARIS (WNS) -- French Foreign Minister Maurice Schumann has reasserted the and instead, compromise Government's intention to maintain the arms embargo againt Israel imposed by former President Charles de Gaulle, He told the National Assembly during the first full scale parliamentary debate on foreign affairs that France's Mideast policy was designed to "do nothing whatever which would worsen the arms race in the region."

The Foreign Minister said that self-determination, respect for international law and a balance of power in the area was the basis for France's policy. He urged both sides to implement the United Nations Security Council's Nov. 22, 1967 mideast resolution and said peace would result from the joint efforts of the Big Four.

But one Gaullist deputy questioned the role of the Four Powers and asked, "Would it not be wiser to isolate the affair rather than internationalize it," Another called for an end to the arms embargo because "it has not served its purpose."
