APPEAL TO UN FOR RUSSIAN JEW

NEW YORK -- American Jewish leaders met with the U.S. Representative to the United Nations, Charles W. Yost, and asked the American envoy to help an impoverished Russian Jewish writer emigrate to Israel.

Spokesman for the American Jewish Conference on Soviet Jewry gave Ambassador Yost a letter addressed to the United Nations General Assembly from Mrs. Elizaveta Isaakovna Kapshitzer of Moscow, whose son, Vitold Kapshitzer, has been denied permission to leave the Soviet Union and barred from earning a living there.

His request for emigra-

tion to Israel, filed more than two years ago, resulted in expulsion from his trade union, in which membership is required to work as a writer. For the past two years, Mrs. Kapshitzer wrote, she and her son have been forced to subsist on her pension of 49 rubles a month, about \$40.

In a moving plea, Mrs. Kapshitzer, who described herself as a bedridden invalid, said she was addressing the world organization "with the most insistent request a mother can make: Help my son to leave this country!"
