by "insubstantial" changes. Overall, Israeli officials said they were shocked and dismayed by the Rogers speech. They indicated their belief that it proved that the U.S. was continuously yielding to the Soviet Union and the Arabs without any reciprocal "give". A statement by Russian officials at the United Nations that the Rogers speech was a long overdue step in the right direction and clarification from Washington on the reason behind the Secretary of State's talk only seemed to reaffirm the Secretary of State's talk only seemed to reaffirm the Israeli's fear.

The explanation by State Department officials for Mr. Rogers' speech before an adult education conference was that Washington was aiming to improve U.S. relations with the Arabs and was trying to limit anticipated anti-American statements at the forthcoming Arab summit conference at Rabat, Morocco, by showing the Arabs that the Nixon Administration, on which they had pinned such high hopes, was following a policy of impartiality and "balance" in the Middle East crisis.

The points enunciated by Mr. Rogers in his talk included:

*Jerusalem should be a unified city, open to all with Jordanian representation in its administration.

*The final peace terms between Israel and Egypt should define the conditions and obligations of both sides and include such matters as passage through the Suez Canal and the Straits of Tiran.

*Israel and Egypt should prevent hostile acts originating from their territory — an obvious reference to terrorist attacks.

*The so-called Rhodes formula should be used for peace talks and Big Powers' efforts should be directed to helping the U.N. special envoy Gunnar V. Jarring arrange such discussions.

*The U.S. views the Security Council's resolution Nov. 1967 as meaning that Israel will withdraw from Arab lands under a permanent peace treaty to defined borders which can include the 1949 armistice line but would depend on talks between the parties.

State Department officials said the American point was that recognized lines in effect before the Six-Day War would generally govern as modified by "insubstantial" changes to afford Israel better security lines.

discuss Jordanian-Israeli aspects of the crisis in addition to the points covering Egypt and conveyed to the Soviet Union in a note delivered Oct. 28.

he said 12,000 leaders of that part of the world had been trained in and by Israel.

On the issue of Israel's image in world opinion, he reminded the newsmen that before and during the June 1967 war, world sympathy was shown for Israel but action was not. He said that Britain had decided not to sell its Chieftan tanks to Israel but insisted there was no embargo. No country which bows to Arab pressure, he said, could be an impartial arbitrator in the Middle East dispute.

He said his scheduled meeting with Secretary of State William P. Rogers would be one in which there would be differences but the talks would be in a "friendly atmosphere." He said he planned to ask United States officials to use their influence with the Arab countries for direct peace talks with Israel.
