The Government policies in the new territories which the Premier described as a firm hand but with minimum interference with local authorities - had succeeded, she said, and terroritsts have been unable to gain recruits from the local populace. She also said that Israel's overall situation had not been weakened by the Arab's war of attrition and that the Arab states were suffering from thier policy of no peace, no negotiations.
