Presidents' Conference Elects Wexler Chairman

NEW YORK—Dr. William A. Wexler, president of B'nai B'rith, was elected this week to a one-year term, beginning in January as chairman of the Conference of Presidents of Major American Jewish Organizations. The Conference, composed of 23 national Jewish organizations—religious and secular—is a coalition agency representing the majority of the organized American Jewish community. It serves as a forum to share information, exchange views and plan cooperative action on matters affecting the safety and well-being of Jews in Israel and throughout the world. Dr. Wexler, active in Jewish affairs for more than 30 years, was elected B'nai B'rith president in 1965 and re-elected in 1968. He has also served as a vice-chairman of the Presidents' Conference and chairman of the World Conference of Jewish Organizations and a policy board member of other major Jewish bodies.
