destruction." The Swissair jet went down shortly after taking off from Zurich. Those killed were the nine-member crew and 38 passengers, including six Americans and 16 Israelis. (Shortly before the Swiss plane took off, an Austrian airliner carrying mail from Israel landed safely in Frankfurt, West Germany, after a bomb exploded in the baggage compartment. German police said the device had been intended for an El Al Airline flight which took off at the same time as the Austrian jet. Two Arabs are being hunted in that incident.)

Newspapers and organizations in a number of countries have called for a boycott of all airplane flights to Arab countries until the various Arab governments act to stop the terrorist actions.

The reaction to the sabotage was evident when one organization, the Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine, General Com-



mand, first claimed and then denied credit for the sabotage. A number of Arab newspapers have condemned the act.
