

JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

NEW YORK, (WNS) -- The Central Conference of American Rabbis, the rabbinic body of Reform Judaism, will hold its first convention in Israel on March 6-10. The gathering in Jerusalem will be the 81st. annual convention of the organization.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- The Israeli Ministry of Posts has announced the subjects of five new commemorative stamps to be issued in March.

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Israel expects to export about \$300,000 worth of Passover matzot this year to Eastern Europe.

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- The Bank Leumi will declare a 15 per cent dividend this year, the highest in its history.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Israel built 36,000 residential flats last year, about double the number constructed in 1968, with most of the premises erected by private construction companies.

LONDON (WNS) -- The Zionists Revisionists, a militant Zionists group, has formed a committee that includes an Israeli Cabinet minister and a Knesset member to conduct a public campaign "for the release of Soviet Jews and their natural right to return to their homeland."

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- An Army reserve officer has brought suit in the Supreme Court against the Government to end the exemption of yeshiva students from military service. The suit named Defense Minister Moshe Dayan and the court will have to decide whether Gen. Dayan will be required to answer the suit. While Yeshiva student have been exempt from military service since the state was established in 1948, many still volunteer in the armed forces.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Shimon Peres, Minister-Without-Portfolio who is charged with the economic administration of the occupied lands, said that Israel plans to take steps to improve the conditions of Arabs living in this area.

UNITED NATIONS (WNS) -- Israel has charged the United Nations secretariat, and by implication, Secretary-General U Thant, with suppressing material on Russia's treatment of its Jews as a result of pressure from the Soviet Union.

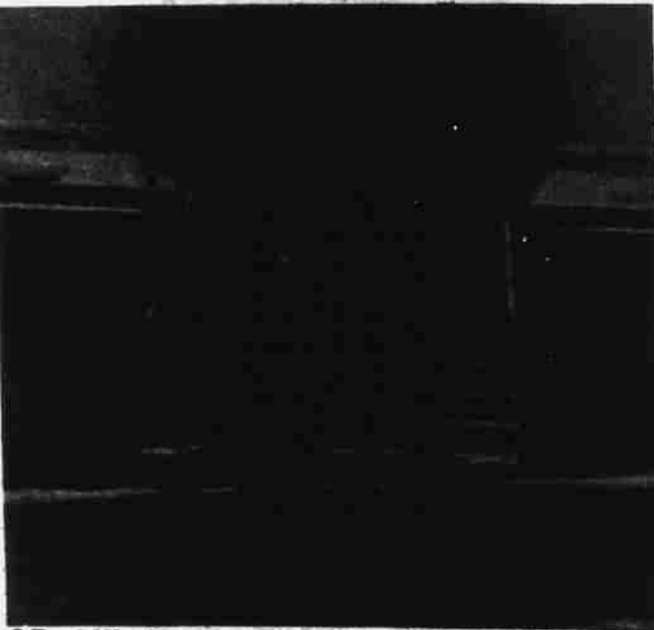
NEW YORK -- Daniel Patrick Moynihan, Counsellor to the President, Ambassador Yitzhak Rabin of Israel, and U.S. Senator Alan Cranston of California will be major speakers at the 1970 Biennial Convention of the National Jewish Welfare Board, to be held at the Washington Hilton Hotel, Washington, D.C. from March 18 to 22.

NEW YORK -- Jewish education has become subject to the same unrest and uncertainty now prevalent on the college campus: "dissatisfaction, if not outright rejection, with what is offered and a disenchantment with efforts on the part of educators to communicate information." B'nai B'rith's commission on adult Jewish education was told by Mrs. Lily Edelman, director of B'nai B'rith's adult education program.

NEW YORK -- Nine American teenagers - five boys and four girls - will represent the United States and Canada at the Eleventh International Bible Contest for Jewish Youth to be held in Jerusalem on Monday, May 11th - the date this year marking the 22nd anniversary of the establishment of the Jewish State. The nine Americans will be among the almost 100 contestants from all over the world participating in the Bible Contest conducted by the World Jewish Bible Society in cooperation with the Department of Education and Culture of the Jewish Agency, Bureaus of Jewish Education in the United States and Canada, and the Gadna Youth Organization in Israel.

NEW YORK -- Thirty-four religious, civil-rights and labor organizations are co-sponsoring publication of a 32-page pamphlet containing the Introduction and Summary of Recommendations from the Final Report of the National Commission on Violence, it was announced today by the American Jewish Committee and the Anti-Defamation of B'nai B'rith.

NEW YORK -- Three "West Coast Special" tours of Israel-In-Depth have been announced by the American Jewish Congress, 590 N. Vermont Ave, Los Angeles. The departures, which are in addition to 235 other AJ-Congress travel programs, will leave directly from Los Angeles by-passing New York on either May 17, July 12 or Sept. 6, for 22 days. Departure is from Los Angeles to Tel Aviv is with a stopover in Paris. Following an extensive visit in Israel, the group will also spend three days in Rome, prior to returning to Los Angeles.

same time, strengthening Moscow's standing in the eyes of the Arabs and also laying the bases of further Soviet aid to the Arab people in their fight against the evils of Zionism and Israeli aggression. But it was doubted that this help would extend to Russian pilots flying MIG-23s, the most modern Soviet jet, for Egypt. Such a move, it was believed, would stir up more anti Arab feeling among the Russian people who have not been too friendly to Arab visitors and who resent material sent to the Arabs while their own needs are not fulfilled, diplomatic observes noted.)
