

Big Complex For Fashions Due in Calif.

ESCONDIDO, Calif.-A 50-building, two-million square-foot industrial park for the men's fashion industry is planned here by A. J. Fenster & Associates, Los Angeles.

Al Fenster, president, cstimates the cost will be \$35 million. He personally is underwriting \$15 million, with the remaining \$20 million loan secured from an

insurance company at 734 per cent interest.

Each building in the park-like complex, will comprise 100,000 square feet, on two floors. Free lodging, in an adjacent trailer park, along with recreation facilities will be provided workers, many of whom are expected from nearby Tijuana, across the Mexican border, Fenster says. Completion is set for December 1970.
