FIRST DAY COVERS

The entire staff of Las Vegas' Stardust Hotel is in a great state of excitement over the forthcoming Moby Dick embossed 6-cent envelope bearing a photo of the Stardust's Moby Dick Restaurant and the words: "A Whale of An Envelope. From the Moby Dick Restaurant, Stardust Hotel, Las Vegas, Nevada."

The Moby Dick will be an official first day cover participant when the commemorative is issued on March 7. The dinery, like the embossed envelope, honors the whaling industry and Herman Melville, the 19th century writer best remembered for his stirring tale of the sea, "Moby Dick."

The commemorative, first issued since the New York World's Fair salute in 1964 will sell for 8 cents and be issued at New Bedford, Mass., past headquarters of the whaling fleet. The stamp is designed in a blue oval in which is set Moby Dick, the great white whale. Above the whale in white is Herman Melville's name. Underneath the whale are the words: "Moby Dick, United States, 6," also in white.

The Stardust Hotel is offering a limited quantity free to the public on a first come, first served basis.
