

UNITED SYNAGOGUE OF AMERICA FOREST IN JERUSALEM

History will be again made in Jerusalem during the week of June 21st, 1970 when the dedication of the United Synagogue of America Forest in Jerusalem will take place as on of the high-

lights of the Biennial Convention of the World Council of Synagogues. Announcement of the new forest was made jointly by Jacob Stein, president of the United Synagogue of America, and Dr. Milton Aron, executive vice-president of the JNF. Scores of synagogues have already indicated their intention to participate in the dedication of their own individual synagogue projects as part of the dedication of their own individual synagogue projects as part of the dedicatory program for the forest in June 1970. From every

part of the United States, reports are coming in detailing the activities and special programs devoted to the interests of the United Synagogue Forest.

The forest, to be planted in cooperation with the Jewish National Fund near Sanhedria west of Jerusalem, will adorn the slopes of an imposing hill, the first to come into view on the Jerusalem skyline as one arrives from Tel Aviv. It will bring added beauty and security to the Holy Land. Leaders of the Conserva-

tive movement have lauded the establishment of the forest as another important link creating a new bond between our people and the people of Israel. They have called upon congregations throughout the country to do their fair share to complete this auspicious project.

Spearheading the nationwide effort is the Israel Affairs Committee of the United Synagogue, with David Zucker as its national chairman, Samuel Rothstein, ashonary

chairman of the Forest Committee, and Dr. Morris Fond serves as co-chairman. Rubin R. Dobin, Chairman of Special Projects for the Jewish National Fund, is serving as coordinator. Rabbi Morris Feldman, director of the Israel Affairs Commission, is acting as consultant. National headquarters for the project have been established at 42 E. 89th Street, New York City 10021.

LONDON (WNS) -- Self-exiled Russian author Anatoli Kuznetskov, who wrote a book on the Babi Yar massacre and said he knows more about it than "anyone else in the world", described a letter written by Ukrainian Jews alleging that Zionists collaborated with the Nazis in the Babi Yar killing of Jews as "carrying zynicism beyond the belief of comprehension." He said the letter published in the Communist Party newspaper Pravda was proof that "the Jews in the Ukraine are so intimidated that they are ready to sign anything." The author lived in Kiev near Babi Yar at the time of the massacre and said that Soviet censors had completely mutilated his account of the event. He is planning to publish the uncensored text of the book.

PHILADELPHIA -- "The State of Israel is a Jewish State rather than merely a state for Jews," said Dr. Abraham I. Katsh, president of The Dropsie University, Philadelphia, in commenting on the "who is a Jew?" controversy resulting from a decision of the High Court in that country.
