## ARAB STATE IN MANDATE AREAS

# IMPORTANT STEP TO END MIDEAST WAR

JERUSALEM (WNS)—Israeli Foreign Minister Abba Eban, on a Arabic language broadcast over Kol Israel radio, has suggested that an independent Palestinian Arab state be established in the former mandate territory.

The broadcast, which was expected to be heard by Palestinian and other Arabs throughout the Mideast, picked up a suggestion advanced by many individuals in Israel and elsewhere as a possible important step to the end of the area's crisis.

Mr. Eban had previously attacked the idea a few months ago when he was questioned about the plan. But in his Arabic language broadcast the Foreign Minister suggested that the Palestinian refugees establish such a state with the exact area of the nation to be determined by negotiations.

Observers viewed statement—one of many in what has taken on the form of a quiet but persistence Israeli peace effort—as possibly indicating that Israel has had some positive response to the plan from Palestinian leaders. It was also considered as an attempt to divide the Arab

terrorists groups from the mass of Palestinian living in Israeli occupied territory and in refugee camps in Jordan and Lebanon.

The latter effort was seen as being aided by the commando groups which have been carrying out a terrorist campaign against Arabs in the occupied lands who work in Israel. The terrorists have killed and wounded a large number of Arabs in their grenade and machine gun attacks.

Mr. Eban also disclosed that Israel has made "nine or 10 serious overtures" to the Arabs to start peace discussions but had been rebuffed each time. He said one attempt involved Christian and Moslem leaders from Jerusalem who had carried messages to Arab leaders.

The Foreign Minister's move came after he had publicly said Israel was prepared to make "startling concessions" to the Arabs to end the area's conflict and Defense Minister Moshe Dayan called for the re-establishment of the ceasefire along the Suez Canal.

But the Israeli effort has failed to elicit any response from the Arab states who

JOYA AT 5th BIRTHDAY PARTY

God, in His infinite wisdom, decided that little Joya Trapani would be better off with Him. He took her on Thursday, May 7, 1970.

As a neighbor and friend of the Trapanis, we have to express our own portion of the deep feeling of emotion that overwhelmed all who know the circumstances. Joya was everyone's version of a "living angel" during her short five years on Earth. She can never be anything less, wherever she is, through eternity.

Nature, being what it is, endows each of us with 100 per cent of what it takes to be a person. It is all there in every human, but the division of flesh and bones and blood, along with the inanimates, varies with each individual. Joya had too much of the angelic, in charm, features, personality and goodness, to allow for the perfect formation of the organs in her body. Her little arteries leading to the heart were twisted.

World's leading specialists performed the first open heart surgery when Joya was two and a half months old. It was determined then the tot was to return at five hoping the arteries would have matured to permit more permanent sealing, allowing nature time to complete the healing of the breach. Last Thursday, the same outstanding medical authorities, during a four hour operation, found the main artery leading to Joya's heart, too tiny to retain a clamp.

### EGYPTIAN PILOTS TALK RUSSIAN

WASHINGTON (WNS)—Senior Israeli diplomats stationed in the United States sounded the alarm over the stepped-up Russian involvement in the Mideast crisis, reports circulating in Washington indicated.

The story, as put together in the American capital, indicated the following:

Israeli leaders have known since early in April that Russian pilots were flying combat missions in Egypt. This information also became known to newsmen but military censorship prevented the story from appearing in Israel or being sent out.

And the extent of the Russian involvement also included some direct combat

between Israeli and Soviet pilots. One incident reportedly involved the downing of an Egyptian plane on a raid in the Suez Canal zone. The pilot's body was reported to be dressed in a uniform with Russian lettering, according to a newsreport which was broadcast on an American all-news radio station but was then not repeated.

The second incident involved the downing of two Russian-made Ilyushin-28 jet bombers and the pilots were reported to be speaking Russian. Two of the jets then made a run over El Arish and were shot down by Israeli jet interceptors. The other bombers remained over the ocean and were not opposed.

### 22nd ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATED

JERUSALEM (WNS)—Israel celebrated its 22nd anniversary of independence with nationwide festivities that includes a display of fireworks and the military ability of its air force and navy.

While no massive military parades were held, the Air Force carried out formation flights of jets headed by United States made F-4 Phantoms and the Navy and Army paratroopers put on a joint display in Haifa.

The day before the nation's statehood was celebrated, Israel honored its war dead with a 24 hr. mourning period. This tribute was highlighted by solemn ceremonies at the
