B'NAI B'RITH ALL OUT FOR RUSSIAN JEWS

NEW YORK (WNS) — B'nai B'rith officials have told leaders of the Student Struggle for Soviet Jewry that they will seek greater organization activity on behalf of Russian Jews, a student leader reported.

Glen Richter, co-ordinator of the student group, said a meeting with B'nai B'rith to discuss that

group's asserted insufficient activity on behalf of Soviet Jewry was "very constructive."

The student organization suggested that B'nai B'rith reprint appeals from Soviet Jews as newspaper and magazine ads, that it initiate a regular Soviet Jewry newsletter and that it create action committees for special

crises like the arrest of the "Leningrad 8" for their alleged role in a "plot" to hijack a Russian airliner.

B'nai B'rith officials told the students the organization has taken out such ads but that the newsletter was a very costly project. The special action committee suggestion was being considered by the organization.

(In Israel, Hebrew University president Avraham Harman said that some 400 Soviet Jews so far had signed petitions and open letters with their full names and addresses demanding the right to emigrate to re-unite with their families in Israel. He is the president-designate of the Public Council for Soviet Jewry, a new organization whose aim is "to join its voice to the all-embracing Jewish protest

headed up the job of recruiting and training a network of German national to work as agents to collect reliable information on Russian troop strength, maneuvers and supplies during the Berlin crisis in 1951 to determine if the Soviets would invade West Germany.

As a state senator, he realized that pollution would become a major crisis and returned to college at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, to learn about the problem.

The upshot was that Sen. Hecht became a leading public advocate for realistic, workable pollution control legislation as he carried his message to scores of civic, business, professional and social organizations.

Married to a former school teacher, Sen. Hecht resides in Paradise Valley with his wife and two children.

ISRAELITE ADS PAY

RED MIDEAST PEACE PLAN

JERUSALEM (WNS) — The reception being given by the Arab states and the Big Powers to a new Russian Mideast peace plan was closely being watched by Israeli leaders.

Egypt, the key Arab state, was expected to indicate support for the Soviet proposal. President Nasser has been meeting with Russian leaders in Moscow and the topics being discussed, diplomatic reports indicated, were both the Soviet and American plans plus Egypt's desire for more military aid from Moscow.

Moscow's pressure on Egypt to obtain a favorable public response was believed to involve the presentation of Russia's bill for past military aid. Most of the armament sent by Russia to Egypt since the Six-Day War has been in the form of gifts or long-term grants and the latter, it was believed, were now due to be collected by Russia.

The United States has so far declined to comment on

the Russian plan. Israeli officials noted that Washington was waiting to see the results of its direct approach to the Arab state. There was some speculation that Cairo may respond favorably to the U.S. move to balance Moscow's effort if President Nasser felt that Russia was applying too much pressure.

The Soviet plan was presented to a meeting of the Big Powers at the United Nations. UN sources said it included the following points:

*Israel would withdraw from the occupied territories, including Jerusalem, and make arrangements to help solve the Palestinian refugee problem.

*The Arabs would end their position of war and recognize the independence and territorial integrity of Israel as a move toward making peace with Jerusalem. They would also end the terrorist activities from their territory.
