## BB AND AJC PRAISE BIS OPS

NEW YORK (WNS) — The anti-Defamation League of B'nai B'rith and the American Jewish Congress have praised the Catholic Bishops' Conference for its declaration calling the Oberammergau Passion Play "offensive" to both Christians and Jews and a "purveyor of hatred and injustice."

The two organizations in a joint statement called the

Bishops' declaration "a sensitive and objective analysis of a long-standing vehicle of injustice not only to Jews but to Christian scripture as well." They noted that the play, produced every 10 years by the citizens of the German town of Oberammergau, despite revisions and a disclaimer of anti-Jewish intent, "remains deeply hostile to Jews and Judaism."

## U.S. BORN PILOT CAPTURED WAS AN ISRAELI SINCE 1961

WASHINGTON (WNS) — The State Department has confirmed that an American-born Israeli was the pilot of a jet shot down by Egypt and that he was captured by the Arabs.

The pilot was identified as Jeffrey Peer, 27, who had lived in Columbus, Ohio, but had been an Israeli citizen since 1961.

The Department also said that Egypt's claim that 20,000 Americans were aiding Israel was equal to the approximate "total number of Americans, including men, women and children of all ages, in Israel and the occupied territories, which includes a substantial number of Americans of Arab extraction living in the occupied territories."

## EVEN MADDOX OUT EL AL RIDES HIGH

AYNESBORO, GA. (WNS) — Gov. Lester G. Maddox, 25 political candidates and 250 spectators walked out of a political rally when a gubernatorial candidate began denouncing Jews, Negroes and Yankees.

Gov. Maddox said "I'm for segregation... but I can't be part of any program that wants to wipe out any race." He noted that candidate J.B. Stoner "was calling people savages and making attacks on what he called blue-bellied Yankees and Jewish-Americans and black Americans."

Governor Maddox cannot succeed himself and he is running for Lieutenant Governor. Joining him in the walkout was C.B. King of Albany, the first black gubernatorial candidate.

El Al Israel Airlines declared a net profit of just under \$1.5 million for the fiscal year of 1969-70, plus over \$1 million which has been set aside for deferred taxes. On net profit alone, this represents a 7 percent return on El Al stock.

This is El Al's eleventh consecutive profit-making year. Revenue in 1969-70 was over \$80 million, an increase of 6.07 percent over the previous year although operating expenses rose in this period by 8.4 percent. This latest profit is the second largest in El Al history. The highest was in 1968-69, when net profit was \$1.8 million, plus \$1.2 million which was set aside for taxes.

Greek officials negotiated with the terrorists for eight hours and then agreed to release the seven commandos held in jail in return for the immediate release of the passengers. The passengers were released and the plane left for Cairo with an International Red Cross official aboard as a guarantor of the agreement. The official, Andre Rochat, Mideast representative of the Red Cross, had played a key role in the negotiations.

Egyptian Pres. Nasser welcomed the seven terrorists when the plane landed in Cairo and called them heroes. Western newsmen reported from Egypt. After dropping off the terrorists, the Greek jet returned to Athens.

### MCGROARTY FOR CONTROLLER
