Larson, who has filed for University Regent in the coming election, announced that his campaign will be based on presenting solutions to the problems facing higher education in Nevada in the seventies. Larson stated that in general there are two problems: first, the national crisis striking many campuses in the form of strikes. demonstrations, and sometimes violence; second, the necessity for the university system to continue to develop to meet the needs of Nevada's growing

population. "The solutions begin," Larson stated, "when two qualities are present in the universities' regents – experience and the ability to communicate both outside the campus with citizens and legislators and within it with students, faculty and administrators."

"I filed for the office of Regent," he continued, "because I believe I possess those two needed qualities."
