"I have always had a basic interest in education, and feel I can be of great assistance in the State's total education system by serving in the Legislature," he said.


Ronzone recently sold his two department stores which the family has owned since 1917. He Chamber of Commerce. remains as a consultant to the Boulevard Mall store.
