RONZONE FOR ASSEMBLY 4

A member of a pioneer Nevada family, R. J. "Dick" Ronzone, has filed for a seat in the state assembly to represent district 4 as a Republican.

Ronzone, 52, of 747 Rancho Circle, is currently in his second term as a University of Nevada Regent. A week ago, he had announced during a regent meeting in Reno he expected to file for the State Senate.

"I have always had a basic interest in education, and feel I can be of great assistance in the State's total education system by serving in the Legislature," he said.

Ronzone recently sold his two department stores which the family has owned since 1917. He remains as a consultant to the Boulevard Mall store.

Long active in civic affairs, Ronzone served on the Clark County Board of School Trustees in the early 1950s and was president of the Las Vegas

Chamber of Commerce.

He was born in Manhattan, Nev., a small mining community where his parents moved in 1904 from Nome, Alaska. Manhattan was the scene of the Ronzone family's first venture into retailing.

WHAT'S HAPPENING IN ISRAEL

Regardless of how complete your itinerary may be, you'll have some "free" afternoons and evenings in Tel Aviv, Haifa or Jerusalem. Deciding how to spend that time on your own can be great fun, according to El Al Israel Airlines.

The first thing you'll want to find out is what's happening, and where. At home you'd look through the pages of your daily newspaper, and El Al recommends that you do the same in Israel — by picking up a copy of the English-language daily, the Jerusalem

Post. Here, on the entertainment pages, in addition to listings for current theatre, cinema, concerts and other special events, there's a column, written especially for tourists, called "What's on."

You'll learn that there are free conducted tours of many points of interest in Jerusalem, Tel Aviv, Haifa and elsewhere in Israel. The column is a fine source for information about local museums and exhibitions, with up-to-the-minute listings of the days and hours they're open as well as their

locations and, in many instances, how to reach them via public transportation.

In addition, many unusual activities are recommended, such as the sound and light show, "A Stone in David's Tower", currently on view in Jerusalem at David's Tower, next to the Jaffa Gate; the Friday afternoon Synagogue Tour; free showings of films on Israel; and the "Oneg Shabbat" and Israeli Folklore Evenings held every Saturday night.

Many of the activities listed are free, and admission fees, wherever charged, are minimal. In some instances it's necessary to make your

reservations in advance.

For further information about where to go and what to do in Israel, tourists are invited to contact any of the Government Tourist Information Offices throughout the country, or the Voluntary Tourist Service desks, now located in the lobbies of the major hotels in Tel Aviv and Herzliya.

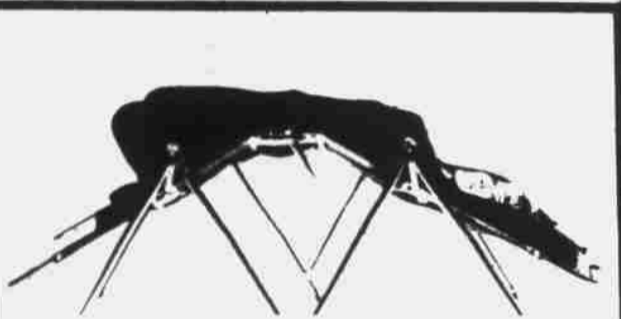
