METCALF FOR STATE SEN.

Bryan R. Metcalf, Democrat, filed for office of State Senator in District 3. He was born in Joplin, Missouri. His family moved to Texas, where he was orphaned as a child. Bryan worked continuously for a better education, and taught as principal in the High School in Del Rio, Texas. He was a Staff Sergeant in the Air Force in World War II. He received an honorable discharge in the state of Nevada and stayed on to make Las Vegas his home.

He is the owner and operator of Clark County Security and Metcalf Detective Agency, and the Past District 2 Commander of the American Legion. He returned to the University of Southern Nevada 5 years ago to get a B.A. in Arts and Humanities. His fields were English and political education.

Bryan is working towards

his M.A. as an educational administrator, and is in his final exams. He is a member of the National Sheriff's Ass. the Nevada Constable Ass. He is an officer of Nevada Southern alumnae. A member of Nevada State Education Ass. and NEA. Bryan is also a member of the Fraternal Order of Elks and Treasurer of The Artists and Craftmen's Guild.

He is married to Jessie Metcalf, a member of the Las Vegas Board of Realtors, and the Las Vegas Press Club. Bryan and his wife are both members of the Democratic Central Committee. Bryan Metcalf will be a speaker in Washington D.C. at the I.P.A. Convention; his subject "Finding Direction in 1970. STORMSON, VAN BETTEN FOR BD. OF ED.

Mrs. Jacqueline Stormson, a long time Nevada resident active in civic affairs and employed as an Instructional Media Specialist, recently joined forces with Herman Van Betten, an English Professor at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, active in academic circles.

They are candidates for State Board of Education.

Their stands on educational issues reflect their familiarity with the important issues in education and their high ideals for excellence in education for the entire state of Nevada. Although both are residents of urban areas, their interests are not restricted to the cities, as is indicated in their stand that the educational resources in the rural areas should be second

to none. This interest is further brought out by their official stand that "one of the first actions of the board should be to apportion itself to give fair and responsive representation to all areas of Nevada."

The candidates pledged to propose means to encourage teachers who can make learning an adventure, and they propose to hold some meetings of the State Board of Education in locations other than Carson City, to keep in closer contact with parents and teachers around the state. Stormson and Van Betten pledged to represent statewide rather than regional interests.

Mrs. Stormson has a degree in political science from the University of California, Los Angeles, and has done graduate work at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, in education, special education, and history. She is a member of the Ne-

vada Library Association, American Association of University Women, and the League of Women Voters. She and her husband Geoffrey live in Las Vegas with their three children.

Van Betten, 38, studied at the Universities of Pittsburgh, Maryland, Texas, and the University of Southern California. He holds degrees in French, German, and comparative literature. He is a veteran of the U. S. Army, where he served as an Education and Public Relations Specialist. He is vice-president of the Robert E. Lake PTA, is vice-president of the Las Vegas Chapter of the American Association of University Professors, and is President - elect of the Las Vegas chapter of Phi Kappa Phi, an honorary association for outstanding students and faculty. He and his wife Patricia live in Las Vegas with their four young children.
