JOHNSON FOR ASSEMBLY 4

Freeman Johnson has filed for his third try at the Republican nomination for a District Four Assembly seat.

Johnson won the GOP primary in 1966 and 1968, but lost both elections. He finished 12th in 1968 in the race for nine seats.

His platform remains the same as in 1968: a greater share of education dollars for UNLV; 30-39 week limit on unemployment compensation instead of the current 26-week limit; school district reapportionment; no state income tax; further compensation and rehabilitation programs for blind and disabled persons; a three percent bond limit instead of the current one per-

cent limit; and bidding of state construction projects in this area to be built primarily in winter months, when workers are more often laid off.

"I'm not promising these things, because it takes a lot of Legislatures to do something," he said.

Johnson has been in construction work for most of his life and is a 12-year member of the Carpenter's Union, in which he has held elective office and is chairman of the Health and Welfare Trust. He is a 26-year resident of Nevada.

LONDON (LNS) . . . Lubavitch House, the British office of the Lubavitcher movement, has announced the publication of a new anthology, entitled 'Challenge' - An Encounter with Lubavitch-Chabad. This new book outlines some of the doctrines of the Chabad Chassidic philosophy, as well as the aims and development of the Lubavitcher movement from its inception, nearly two hundred years ago, to the present day. NEW YORK . . . Thirty-eight American college students, including four from Canada, left for a year's study at the Hayim Greenberg Institute in Jerusalem. The Hayim Greenberg Institute, which is sponsored by the Department of Education and Culture of the Jewish Agency for Israel, gives additional educational training in Hebrew, Judaica, and Israel, on a collegiate level to Jewish youth from the Diaspora.

NEW YORK . . . A project which has been in the planning stages for the last three years became a reality with the departure of 21 families who will join ten other American families already in Israel in forming a non-agricultural, cooperative community in Israel known as Garin Hamagshimim -- Seed of the Fullfillers. Upon arrival in Israel they will enter an absorption center, a temporary housing accommodation where they will be taught to speak Hebrew in order to be assimilated into Israeli society. The other member families of the Garin will join the first group during the course of the year and by the summer of 1971 the proposed project will include 70 American and 30 Israeli families. This goal of 100 families was selected with the thought that such a group would be large enough to function as a viable community and yet small enough to retain a certain closeness and warmth.

NEW YORK . . . A record breaking number of more than 430 American and Canadian Jews departed on the T.S.S. Anna Maria to settle in Israel. According to Col. Nachum Golan, Director of the Israel Aliyah Center, the total consisted of 108 families numbering 395 persons and 35 individuals.

NEW YORK . . . Geared to the enhancement of a sense of Jewish peoplehood, the 28th annual observance of Jewish Book Month from November 20 to December 20 under the sponsorship of the Jewish Book Council of the National Jewish Welfare Board will have as its theme "Around the World with Jewish Books," which also key-noted last year's event.
