

# Only in Vegas

Nevada Senator Howard W. Cannon today offered legislation which would increase from \$2,000 to \$2,500 a year the amount of earnings a social security recipient could receive before reduction of benefits.

At this critical time when the campuses of the University of Nevada, both at Reno and Las Vegas, are about to reopen for student life, the Las Vegas branch of the NAACP feels it incumbent upon its leadership to bring to the attention the position of the NAACP on the campus unrest, and especially to urge that the governing bodies of the University, on both campuses, begin to include more students in the government and in establishing rapport and better racial and ethnic relationships as a policy of the campus.

Kit Carson Elementary School, which has lost more than half its enrollment under the Clark County School District voluntary elementary school integra-

tion plan, has openings for about 200 white students who want intensified instruction in reading, according to assistant principal Roger Gehring.

The school has been converted into a "Special Reading Center" and, "this means every student gets special attention in reading. If he needs remedial help, he will get it. If he reads well and wants enrichment, he'll get that, too."

KLTV, Channel 10, was honored by the Institute of Lifetime Learning for "Gold or the Tinkle of Brass", a 30-minute documentary on retirement attitudes of teenagers, active workers, and persons long since retired.

Federal funds totaling \$9.5 million for Nevada's educational programs were "rescued from certain drastic slashes" when the Senate voted to override the President's veto of the Education money bill, said Nevada Sen. Howard W. Cannon, who voted with a majority of his colleagues.
